4. President Welcome and Annual Report

Welcome to the 2022 AGM of Northern Steel Car Club

2022 saw the club grow despite the impact of COVID, with club membership doubling in the last 12-month period

This is the second year of running the club, we continue to learn as we grow to further develop the club into what our members want.

Membership -

2021 AGM we had 300 active members

2022 AGM we had 617 active members

634 members at the 30th June 2022 with 617 members renewed so far for the 2022/2023 year

Currently 681 cars on C4C out of the 617 members.

Interest with club memberships is continuing to climb at a rate of 2-3 member per year. No plans to cap membership at this time.

Finances:

2021 - AGM - \$16,500 in the bank

2022 - AGM - \$48,140 in the bank at 30 June 2022

Funds in the bank have more than doubled over the past 12 months. *2022 member tees are yet to be paid from this amount

We could not have forecast this growth last year and it is yet to be seen if this will reduce, stabilize, or continue to grow. The committee is considering the best way to use the funds for the benefit of the club; however, the positive is we are not wasting members money!!

5. Treasurers Report

BANK:

\$16,500 in the bank at the last AGM in July 2021

\$48,140 on 30 June 2022

DONATIONS:

2021/2022 - Raised \$3380 in donations Paid out \$6000. See presidents notes for details on where the donations were made to.

2020/2021 - \$1960 paid out in donations.

FUNDRAISING:

\$2129 made in fundraising due to the Bunnings Sausage Sizzle in November 2021. This fundraising venture saw us break the record for the highest grossing Bunnings Sausage Sizzle for Bunnings Joondalup even though we were down in the under cover car park area.

ADMIN:

Costs of \$6000- Including restricted use stickers, insurances, WASMA membership website costs, committee meeting venues, admin costs for supplies to run the club, computer for admin.

POSTAGE:

\$1470 including member shirts postage and key ring postage in this financial year and some member shirt postage from last year.

MERCHANDISE:

Spend \$18,726 last years member shirts, beanies, hoodies, t-shirts stickers, hats and key rings and including design costs

Sales \$20,188. Please keep in mind the club subsidised member t-shirts by 50%

MEMBERSHIP:

\$44,771 in memberships from 1JUL 2021 to 30 June 2022

617 active members and growing week on week

Out of the 617 members, 681 cars have been registered for C4C – this equates to a saving of \$408K across the club on the restricted use rego.
